

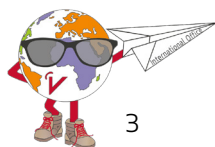

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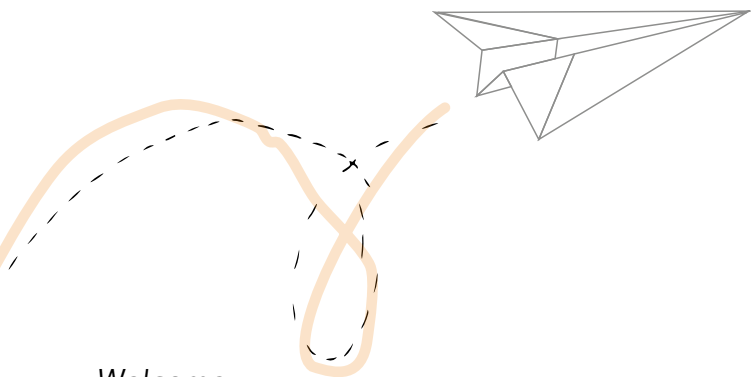
# Willkommen

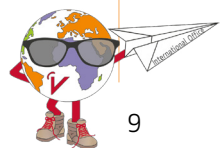

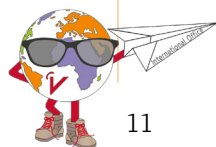

## Anglistik *English Studies*

**Prof.in Dr.in Jane Hodson**  
United Kingdom, University of Limerick

Jane Hodson is Professor of English Language and Literature at the University of Sheffield. Her research interests lie at the interface of language and literature, and she is particularly interested in the way in which style is contested at an ideological level. She has published on Jane Austen, Mary Wollstonecraft and the language of Gothic literature. Her current area of research is the representation of non-standard language in literature, film and television. In 2013 she completed the AHRC-funded project '*Dialect in British Fiction 1800-1836*' and she has published a monograph '*Dialect in Literature and Film (2014)*' and an edited volume '*Dialect and Literature in the Long Nineteenth Century (2017)*'. She is now working on new project, exploring the representation of World Englishes in English-language film, television and literature.

**Prof. Dr. Hartmut Stöckl**  
Österreich, Paris Lodron Universität Salzburg

Hartmut Stöckl is full professor of English and Applied Linguistics at Salzburg University, Austria. His main research areas are in semiotics, text/discourse/media linguistics & stylistics, pragmatics and multimodal communication. A recurrent theme surfacing in most of his work is a concern with a pluralistic theory of the multimodal text and effective analytical methods for uncovering its structures and styles. He is particularly interested in the linkage of language and image in modern media, typography and an aesthetic appreciation of advertising. His latest edited volumes are: the Handbook Language in Multimodal Contexts (2016, de Gruyter), Shifts Toward Image-Centricity in Contemporary Multimodal Practices (2020, Routledge/ New York), and The Rhetoric of Multimodal Communication (2021, Special Issue/Visual Communication).

**Prof.in Dr.in Barbara Caprara**  
Italien, Universität Bozen

Since 2005, she is assistant professor in General Didactics at the Faculty of Education of the Free University of Bozen Bolzano in Italy. Her research interests are related to the idea of a prepared learning environment to promote free choice and self-education kindergarten and primary schools, to the educational use of environmental and natural resources, and to the dissemination of the Montessori approach.

She is in charge of the course '*Help me to do it myself: introduction to Montessori approach*' for kindergarten and primary teacher students. Recently, she has attended a PhD school in Psychology at the University of Trento, where she has managed a research project about the introduction of three Montessori primary school classes in the public sector, using qualitative such as quantitative methods for data gathering.

She is a member of the steering committee CRESPI, an Italian inter-university educational research centre for teacher training.

In recent years, my attention has focused on analysing frailty indices in the elderly and on Long Term Care for the non-selfsufficient older population.

David James is Reader in Philosophy at the University of Warwick, UK. His main areas of expertise are German Idealism and the social and political philosophy of Jean-Jacques Rousseau. His publications include *Property and its Forms in Classical German Philosophy* (Cambridge University Press, 2023), *Practical Necessity, Freedom, and History: From Hobbes to Marx* (Oxford University Press, 2021) and *Rousseau and German Idealism: Freedom, Dependence and Necessity* (Cambridge University Press, 2013). He is the editor of *Hegel's Elements of the Philosophy of Right: A Critical Guide* (Cambridge University Press, 2017) and (with Günter Zöller) *The Cambridge Companion to Fichte* (Cambridge University Press, 2016). He is currently co-editing a volume entitled *The Empathetic Emotions in the History of Philosophy*, which will be published by Oxford University Press.

## Pädagogische Psychologie

### *Educational Psychology*

**Prof.in Dr.in Ageliki Nicolopoulou**  
Vereinigte Staaten, Lehigh University

Ageliki Nicolopoulou is Professor of Psychology at Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA, USA). She was born and raised in Greece and went to the US for her undergraduate and graduate education, receiving her Ph.D. in Psychology from the University of California-Berkeley. She has taught at the University of California - San Diego, Smith College, and (since 1995) at Lehigh University. She is a sociocultural developmental psychologist whose research interests include the role of narrative and play in development, socialization, and education and the influence of the peer group and peer culture as social contexts for children's language, cognitive, and socio-emotional development. Recently, she has examined the role of fantasy in education, and how we can best harness fantasy, narrative, and play for science education. Her teaching reflects her research interests, including courses on play and narrative and their role in language, literacy, and sociocognitive development and cross-cultural human development. She has published extensively on these topics. Some of her well-known publications include '*The Elementary Forms of Narrative Coherence in Young Children's Storytelling*' (Narrative Inquiry) and '*From Actors to Agents to Persons: The Development of Character Representation in Young Children's Narratives*' (Child Development).

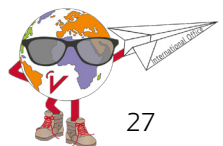
# Soziale Arbeit

## *Social Work*

**Prof.in Dr.in Ulene Schiller**  
Südafrika, University of Fort Hare

Prof.in Schiller started her career as registered social worker in the field of child protection and immediately continued with her postgraduate studies. She held numerous positions at Child Protection Organisations and Child and Youth Care Centres that layed the foundation for venturing into her own Private Practice. This was the inspiration for pursuing her PhD in Forensic Social Work where after she started her career in the academia focussing on practice training of social work students and the University of Pretoria. In 2014 she started her academic career at the University of Fort Hare in 2014 as lecturer and is currently serving in the Department of Social Work and Social Development as an associate professor and Deputy Dean of the Faculty. 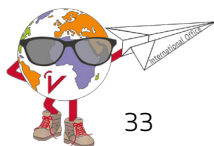

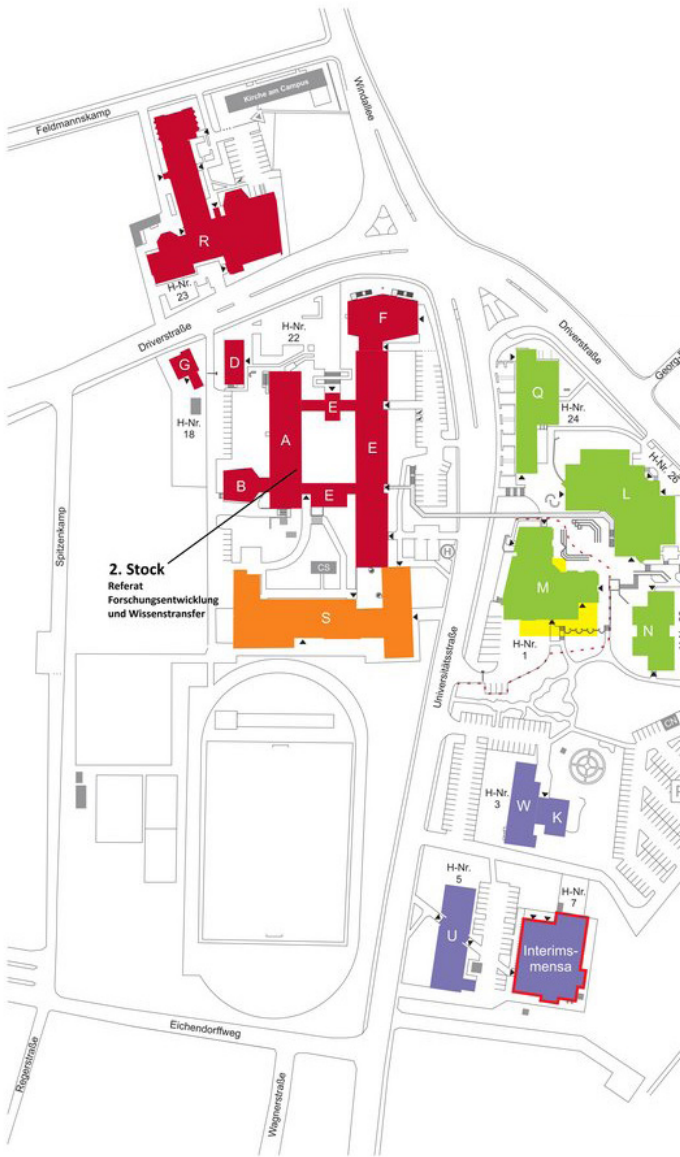
