<p>6. Content</p>		<p>The English-language module deals with the aspects of entrepreneurship and sports. Two topics that play a major role during the current COVID-19 pandemic. Two block courses will lay out the substantial framework in advance of the excursion/field trip by covering the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Definitory approaches towards entrepreneurship - Types of entrepreneurship - Basics on project management - Specifics of the sports industry - ... <p>During these block courses, oral presentations will be developed in so called Working Labs. The structure of the written elaborations will also be defined.</p> <p>The seminar concludes with an excursion/field trip to the International Summer School in Sardinia from September 20th to September 24th 2021. A total of six expertly guided workshop sessions will approach the interactions between entrepreneurship and sports and make it practically tangible in a challenge with a real cooperation partner. A total of five to ten international students will be working together in groups.</p> <p>The six workshop sessions will cover a creative process which starts with development of ideas and leads up to the formation of concrete recommendations for action and finishes with session on visualisation and idea pitching. Team labs around the workshops will ensure that there is sufficient time for exchange and work in each group. The final presentation of the developed ideas in front of the cooperation partners will act as a conclusion to the summer school.</p>
